The financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2026, which include the statement of accounts, have been published on the Council's website at. The statements are unaudited and may be subject to change.

Notice is given that from 1 July 2026 to 11 August 2026 inclusive between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm, Mondays to Fridays, any person interested may inspect and make copies of the accounts of the Council for the year ended 31 March 2026 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating thereto, except as provided for in Section 26 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 in relation to commercially confidential and personal information.

Notice is also given that from 1 July 2026 to 11 August 2026 the auditor, at the request of a local government elector for the Borough, will give the elector or their representative the opportunity to question the auditor about the accounts, and any such elector or their representative may attend before the auditor and make objections under the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 (section 27) regarding a matter where the auditor could take action under that act, namely:

- declare that an item is unlawful (section 28)
- make a report in the public interest (section 24 and Schedule 7 paragraph 1).

No objection may be made unless the auditor has previously received written notice of the proposed objections and its grounds.
