#### Advice and guidance Choosing the right course for you

It is so important that you thoroughly research the choices that you want to make as they will affect important decisions that you will make in the future. Before you decide on your subjects there are a number of people you should talk to. Firstly, you should discuss your options with your parents/carers and what your future plans are. Secondly, you should also discuss your options with your tutor or a member of staff who has known you since you joined the school, as they will have a good insight into what may be your best options.

It is also advisable to speak to the different subject teachers for the choices you want to make and find out what is fully involved with the course you are interested in and whether or not you would be fully suited to it. The Sixth Form team are also an important port of call in finding out about life in the Sixth Form and what is required of you to become a successful Sixth Form student. We are also lucky enough to have a Connexions Advisor in school who will discuss in detail what your future options are. In terms of subjects, there are certain combinations that may be more beneficial for the degree course that you may have currently in mind. If so, you should read page 20 of your Sixth Form Course Guide within your Prospectus and also consult a member of the Sixth Form team.

## Entry Requirements for The Cardinal Wiseman Sixth Form

You need to achieve at least 5 A\*-C GCSE grades including English and Maths (one of which must be at a grade B level) to be able to complete A Levels at the Cardinal Wiseman Sixth Form (see admissions policy and prospectus).

#### AS and A Level courses

Most students are expected to start with FOUR subjects in Year 12 and continue with THREE in Year 13.

When choosing please remember:

- You have to choose 4 subjects you have a choice out of 5 option blocks, please do not tick more than one subject in each block.
- If you have already completed an AS in a subject and you want to carry it onto A2, it must be one of your options. Please make sure you tick the appropriate 'highlighted A2' box.
- Take into consideration what you want to do at university and whether the subjects you choose will help you gain entry.
