Notice is hereby given that, on July 21<sup>st</sup> 2011, the London Borough of Ealing submitted the above development plan document to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for independent examination. The Development (or Core) Strategy sets out a vision for the future development of the borough and covers a 15-year plan period up to 2026. In particular it identifies the broad locations for delivering housing and other strategic development needs, such as employment, retail, leisure, community facilities and other uses. It also sets the context for the other policy documents that make up Ealing's Local Development Framework.
