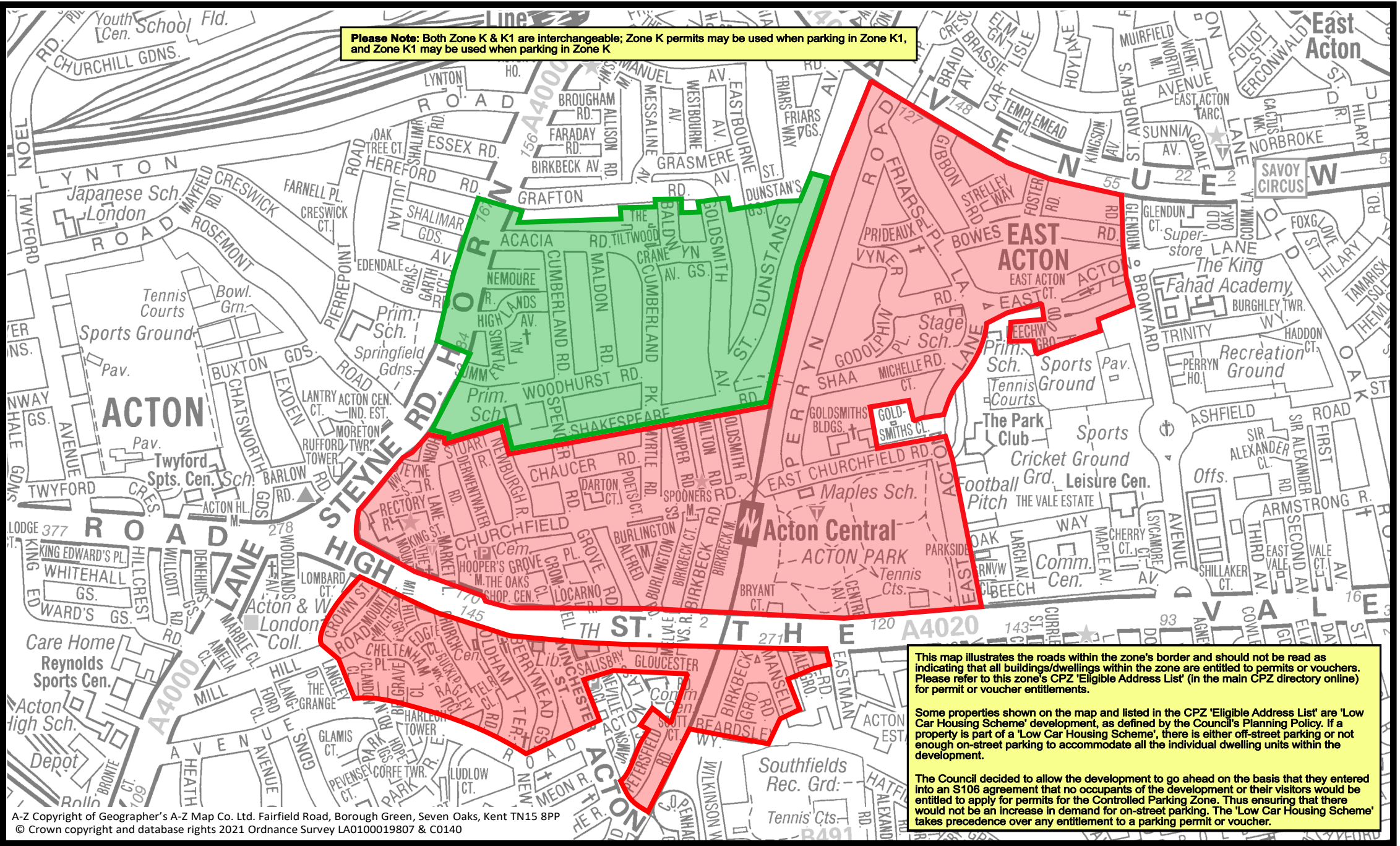


CPZs: Mon - Fri

Zone K
9:30am - 5:30pm

Zone K1
9 - 10am & 3 - 4pm

Please Note: Both Zone K & K1 are interchangeable; Zone K permits may be used when parking in Zone K1, and Zone K1 may be used when parking in Zone K



This map illustrates the roads within the zone's border and should not be read as indicating that all buildings/dwellings within the zone are entitled to permits or vouchers. Please refer to this zone's CPZ 'Eligible Address List' (in the main CPZ directory online) for permit or voucher entitlements.

Some properties shown on the map and listed in the CPZ 'Eligible Address List' are 'Low Car Housing Scheme' development, as defined by the Council's Planning Policy. If a property is part of a 'Low Car Housing Scheme', there is either off-street parking or not enough on-street parking to accommodate all the individual dwelling units within the development.

The Council decided to allow the development to go ahead on the basis that they entered into an S106 agreement that no occupants of the development or their visitors would be entitled to apply for permits for the Controlled Parking Zone. Thus ensuring that there would not be an increase in demand for on-street parking. The 'Low Car Housing Scheme' takes precedence over any entitlement to a parking permit or voucher.
