Notice is hereby given, in accordance with
Regulations 18 and 35 of the Town and Country
Planning (Local Development) (England)
Regulations 2012 that the London Borough
of Ealing has published for statutory pre-
submission consultation a "Planning for Schools
DPD: Publication Version".

(a) Title and purpose of document:

This statutory consultation deals with the
"Planning for Schools DPD: Publication Version"
and associated supporting documentation. The
plan:

- sets out planning policies to help facilitate the provision of schools in the right places and to protect identified sites for education use to meet the identified need and
- identifies possible sites for new primary and secondary schools in the borough.

This iteration of the plan is the version of the plan that the Council intends to formally submit to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for independent examination. When adopted in Summer 2015 it will form part of the Council's suite of documents known as the "Local Plan."
